### Website

### New CLP Safety Data Sheet

You may be aware that it's no longer required to give old style DSD/DPD hazard information in a CLP Safety Data Sheet, so we've made a new style SDS which takes this, and other things into account.

In the new version of the CLP Safety Data Sheet the key differences are:

- No old style hazards in section 2 or 3
- Additional Physical properties displayed
- Toxicological section reformatted to show information by hazard class
- Workplace Exposure limits can now show multiple regional limits for the same item (e.g. show UK and German WEL limits for chemicals in a formulation)
- There's also an advance in translations, so choice properties can now work with translations. The CLP SDS is the first document where this has been implemented. Now instead of using 'Appearance' which is a text property you can use choice properties which are combined for display – APPEARCLARITY, APPEARCOLOUR and APPEARSTATE

Compliance suitability checks are available in key places throughout Formpak, including within Formulation Development. Product formulators can determine the compliance status of a formulation during development, and take the necessary steps to ensure formulations comply to customer, region and application rules.

Document Management can be linked to suitability checking. This means the impact of document revisions can be assessed to ensure ongoing compliance, prior to sending

information to customers.

Suitability and compliance management is configurable directly within the software.
