## **Find Matching Items**

The very first Tip of the Month featured Find Matching Items. Since then new search criteria has been added. Here is a new overview of Find Matching Items. New additions have been highlighted.

Find Matching Items is the key tool for searching and reporting items (raw materials and formulations).

You can use individual or a combination of attributes to find and report items with many configurable options.

Searchable criteria includes:

#### **Item Code**

Search for items with specific Item Codes.

This can be used to find items within a specific code sequence. Codes are also used when adding items from a basket into a Find Matching Items search.

When searching for a code or name. You can add 'wild cards' for a closer match.

For example searching for a name containing 'rose':


- "rose" means "rose" (in upper or lower case) anywhere
- "=rose" means begins with "rose"
- "rose=" means ends with "rose"
- "=rose=" means just "rose"
- "\=rose" means contains "=rose"
- "rose\=" means contains "rose="
- "\=rose\=" means contains "=rose="
- "ro=se" means contains "ro=se"
- "ro\=se" means contains "ro\=se"

Wild cards were previously only available to use when search for Item Names. This functionality is now available when searching the Item Codes also.

#### **Item Name**

Search using Item Names

# Another addition to this group is the 'and/or' functionality when searching by Item Name. 'Short Name' and 'Cross Reference Code' have also been added recently.



#### **Identification Numbers**

Search using Identification Numbers such as CAS and EC numbers.

#### **Item Class**


You can choose to include or omit specific Formulation and Raw Material Item Classes in your search.

#### **Composition Details**

In this section you can choose to include criteria based on the composition of an item such as the status of 'Preserve When Exploding' or the 'Component Count'.

You can also search for items containing specific components.

A searchable attribute recently added to this group is 'Used in Complex Raw Materials'.



### **Unit Price**

Find items within a specific price range.

'Costing Method' is another recent addition.

#### Sales

Search for items by sales activity, including if it has been sold or not. You can also search for items that were last sold within a specified time frame.

#### Samples

Like Sales, you can also search for items that have sampled, and last sampled within a specified time frame.

#### **Library Details**

In this section you can add criteria to find items linked to parties such as customers and suppliers. Include Character Class, Character Notes and Sensory Descriptions in your search to find items with similar characteristics.

'Sensory Description' was added in 2018 and 'Exclusive Party' was added earlier this year as searchable attributes.

#### **Suitability Checking**

You have the option to include a suitability check for the items in your search. If selected, this will open further options for the suitability check.



#### **Property**


Searching using properties is a key feature of Find Matching Items. You can use a single property or a combination of properties in your search. You can also choose to find items with a specific value for the property.

'Property Calculation' was added as a searchable attribute last year. It allows you to specify if items have property calculation enabled or disabled.

#### **Creator and Modifier**

You can search for items created by specific users, with the option to specify a time frame.

A recent addition allows you can also find items that have been modified or had the composition modified by specific users, including the option to add a time frame.



#### **Search Results and Reporting**

The items found based on the search criteria are listed in alphabetical order. You can re-order the items based on the other information such as Code or Unit Price by clicking the column headers.

From your search results, you are given the option to print a customisable report containing a summary of the search criteria submitted and a table listing the search results. There are also quick links to print documents and labels, check suitability, add to a basket and view details of an item.




## Mini Tip

Here is a tip when using the smart search in the side menu. You can abbreviate the name of the function to search quicker. For example, 'Find Matching Items' can be found by searching 'FMI'. Please note that the abbreviation needs to be entered in uppercase. Please see other examples below:


WIP - for Search for Work In Progress
